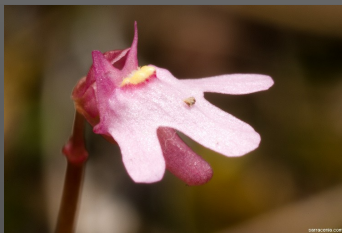
Vicious Plants

The 'Bark' side of the force

Did you know that plants have a fearsomely horrible side? The 'Bark' side of the force. The bark of a tree is 99% **dead** cells. And its three outer parts: phloem, cambium and xylem protect the wood inside. Phloem carries food from the leaves to the roots. Every year, the cambium makes a new layer of phloem and a new layer of xylem. The old phloem turns into bark and the old xylem turns into a ring of wood, so you can tell a tree's age by counting its rings.



Deadly Sweethearts



Let us introduce a quixotic-minded plant that uses its 'pretty' face to get food. How?

The bug-eating Australian plant is called the **pink petticoat plant** because it looks like a **tiny pink petticoat**. You may think it is very beautiful but it traps unwary insects that crawl inside. Then it eats them **alive**.

Frustrating Fungi

There are different kinds of fungi. Mushrooms are eatable fungi. Toadstools are fungi that are uneatable and they are probably **poisonous**. The most poisonous is the Death Cap which is white in colour. It is NOT wise to pick up fungi in the wild. They may be more poisonous than bee stings.



Fungi spread by making tiny spores that are blobs made of single cells. Spores go EVERYWHERE. The spores are **tough** and they can survive in **boiling water**, **freezing weather**, floating in the vast sea and floating in the air as high as a jet airliner.

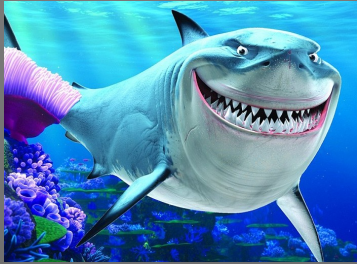

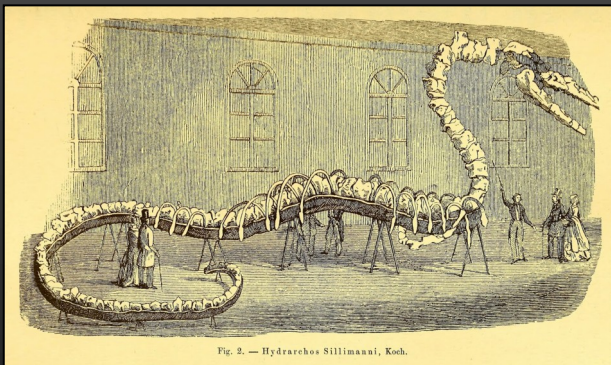


Fig. 2. — Hydrarcho Sillimanni, Koch.

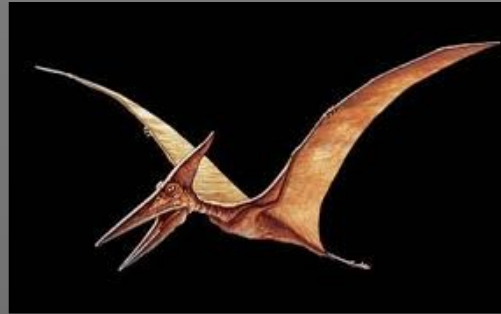
"That explains it," Dr. Quixotic sighed depressingly. "So, my discovery was a total lie."

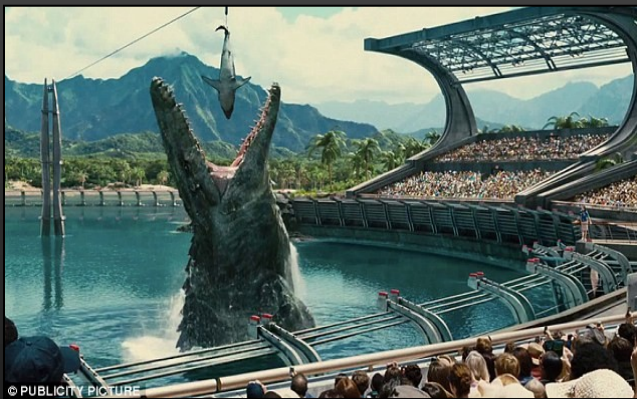

“How perfect you are, Peter,” Dr. Quixotic even made a name for the new dinosaur!

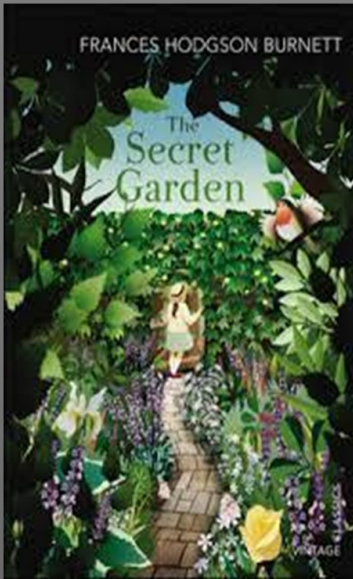

The Secret Garden is a novel written by Frances Hodgson Burnett.

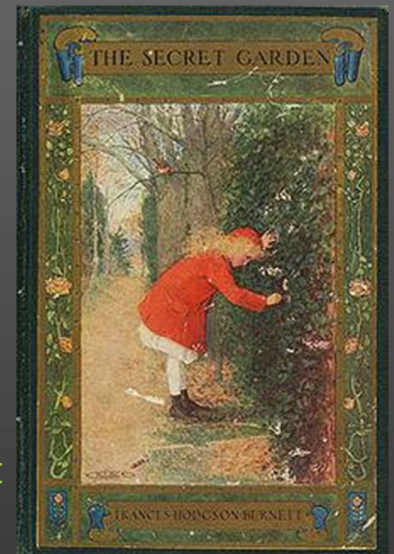
This book is about a selfish girl named Mary who was born in India. Her parents left Mary at home with servants.

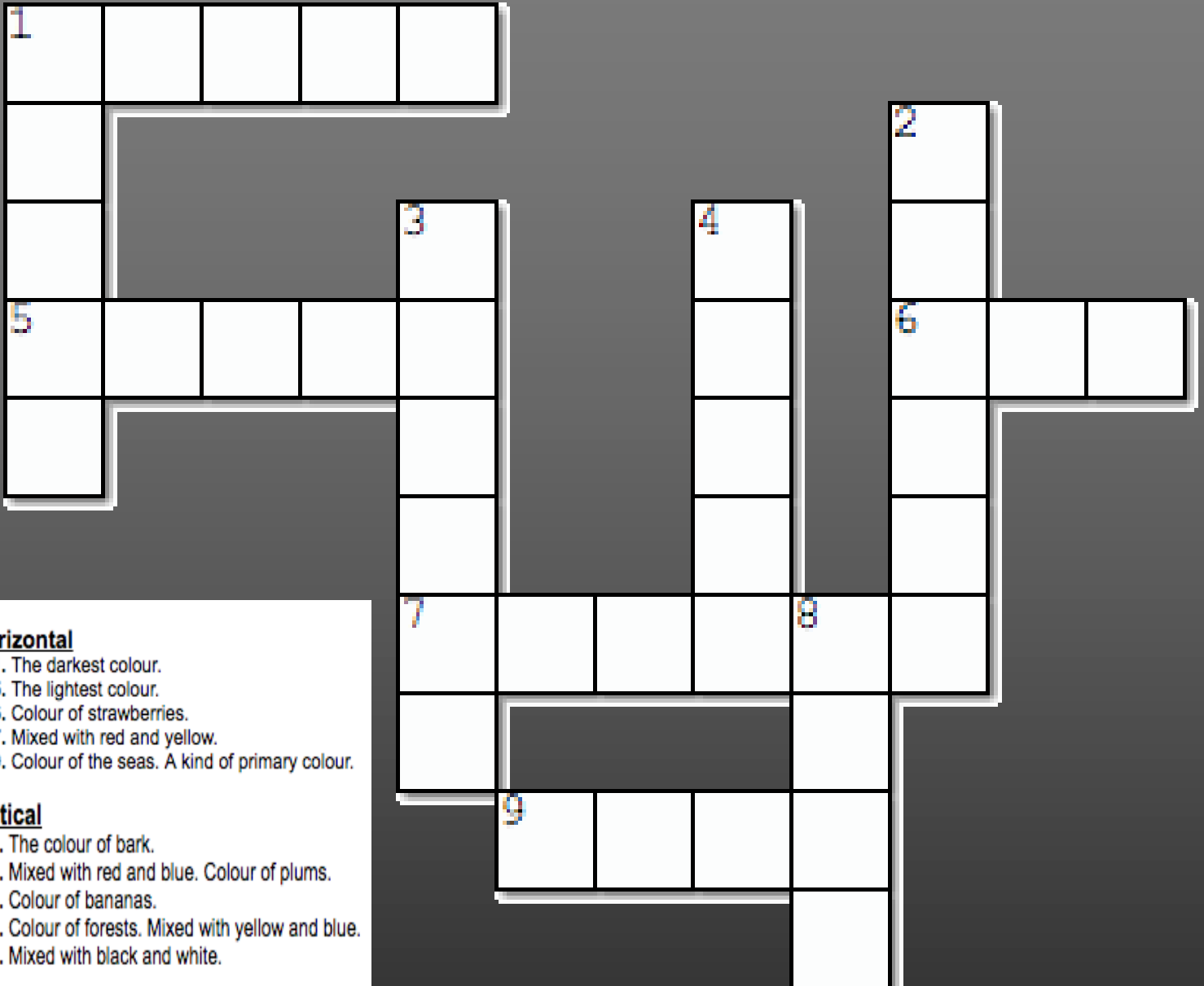
