Aloha! I am Joyce, the editor of this year's LMC Star newsletter.


In this year's newsletter, a wide range of interesting and entertaining topics and issues will be discussed and presented to the LMC family!

The Flying Dutchman


Many people believe that when the Dutchman is on the ship and you go inside you never come out. The Dutchman is on a missing ship. It stays on the missing ship

Francis Lam Pou-chuen

You may not recognize his face, but you'll certainly know his voice. **Francis Lam Pou-chuen** was the senior voice actor on TVB.

He originally applied for a job at TVB after he had seen the Cantonese version of the cartoon, Tarzan.



Lam had voiced *Doraemon* since the very first episode was broadcast by TVB in 1981. He continued to be the voice of Doraemon until his death. His only gap was in 1992 when he went over to Asia Television for a short period.

Doraemon is the most important character in his career. Voicing Doraemon has made him a more cheerful person. "Watching more cartoons generally has that effect." he said. 7

Doraemon is always there for Nobita
(Big Bear) when he gets into trouble. He
wasn't originally a very helpful person, but now he
helps others more.

Other roles that Lam had voiced include Garfield and Amuro Ray in *Mobile Suit Gundam* amongst others.

Outside animation, he was also the voice of the corrupt Qing dynasty official Heshen in the 2001 Chinese television series *The Eloquent Ji Xiaolan*. He was also the usual voice for Sammo Hung and George Clooney in Cantonese dubs of their films²

Unfortunately, Lam died on the 2nd of January, 2015. Many people were sad as Lam Pou Chuen's voice fills their childhood memories. Noone will be able to replace him.






You may have more chance to fill bonus squares like 'double word score' and get more points.





According to local folklore, a deity named Takemikazuchi arrived in the old capital riding a white deer to act as its protector, and as a result of this legend, for the last 1,300 years, the deer of Nara have been considered sacred and divine. Killing one of these sacred deer was a capital offense punishable by death up until 1637. After World War II, the deer were officially stripped of their sacred status, and were instead designated as national treasures and are protected as such.




